# MANSW Conference 2006

MANSW's Annual Conference 2006 will be held at the Novotel Brighton Beach, Brighton le sands on Friday 8<sup>th</sup>, Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> September. Our conference will include a combination of keynote addresses, presentations and workshop sessions with approximately 9 different workshops/ presentations in each session.
